


#### **A Letter To Our Potential Donors**

When my co-founder and I started EWAAB, we were motivated by personal experiences and the experiences of women that we knew to be hardworking but had faced similar challenges while in university. We wanted to create a mentorship program that could strengthen the confidence of women, provide them with opportunity, and connect them to a sustainable network. Neither of us then had any idea what we were getting into.

In a short period of time, EWAAB has transformed from an idea to a mentorship program to a non-profit that has been able to make an impact with a lot of woman-power, but with limited funds. So far, EWAAB has impacted **27 university mentees** with a team of **30+ volunteers**, and **50+ members** of the external community. In order to fulfill our mission, we are need of financial support that can sustain our mentorship program as well as provide greater opportunity and connection for our mentees.

We believe in the importance of developing our university women prior to entering the workforce. While we are advocates for female leadership, we consider the increase in the number of female leaders to be a byproduct of our mentorship program, Our main focus is helping young women feel confident and providing opportunities for them to explore any path that they wish to take in life. Please help our university women feel encouraged and connected as they enter into the workforce; every young woman deserves to explore her passion with the confidence to succeed.


